**Holy Thursday April 1st 3:00—5pm** Cleaning vessels & candelabras, setting up bowls, pitchers, towels, decorating Parish Hall with flowers, plants, candles, cloths for Adoration.

**6:30pm** Prepare luminarias— fill bags with sand for tea lights lining path from church to hall

**Easter Vigil 9am—1pm Sign up at the Welcome Table or the Parish Center or call 949-4300!:** move pieces of baptismal pool from sacristy storage room to church; carefully clean and assist in rebuilding; fill baptismal pool. Some muscles are needed.

Decorate church sanctuary, chapel, vestibule, banner across choir loft; banners on ambo, sanctuary walls

Decorate Parish Hall; put up easter wreaths on walls, flowers in front of altar, pedestals, hall vestibule, in front of hall.

Decorate exterior of church, Parish Hall and Parish Center. Set up fire pit for Vigil; set up ambo, small table, holy water stand, book stand in front of Parish Center

**Easter** Greet, smile, make everyone feel welcome at Mass in the church, Parish Hall, Parish Center, walkways, & parking lot! Alleluia!
